ABOUT THE ARTIST

Jina Park (*1980), based in Berlin, draws on her personal experience of living between cultures. Her meticulous use of egg tempera creates surreal landscapes where memory, fantasy, and cultural fragments converge. Influenced by the non-linear perspectives found in East Asian painting traditions, Park constructs a “house of wonder” inhabited by exotic flora, fauna, and artefacts, interwoven with symbolic elements. Her compositions pose questions about cultural belonging, appropriation, and identity. Through repeated motifs of treasure, guardian, and thief, she encourages reflection on postcolonial power dynamics and Western perceptions of the ‘foreigner,’ opening space for multiple perspectives shaped by cultural difference.

독일 베를린에서 거주하고 활동하는 박지나(*1980) 작가의 작업은 서로 다른 문화를 접하며 살아가는 개인적 경험에서 출발한다. 작가는 정밀한 에그 템페라 기법을 통해, 기억과 환상, 문화적 파편들이 충돌하는 초현실적인 시각 세계를 회화 속에 펼쳐낸다. 동아시아 회화 전통의 고정된 시점이 없는 구성 방식에서 영감을 받아, 그녀의 화면에는 이국적인 식물, 동물, 유물들이 혼재하며 다양한 은유적 요소들이 공존하는 ‘경이로운 방’이 형성된다. 이는 문화적 소속감, 전유, 정체성에 대한 질문으로 이어진다. 작가는 ‘보물’, ‘수호자’, ‘침략자’라는 반복적인 도상을 통해 탈식민주의적 권력 관계와 ‘이방인’을 바라보는 서구의 시선에 대한 성찰을 끌어낸다. 그로 인해, 작품은 관객의 문화적 배경에 따라 서로 다른 해석과 질문을 허용한다.



ABOUT THE ARTIST

Jukhee Kwon(*1981) is an artist who transforms discarded and timeworn books into entirely new sculptural forms. Believing that destruction is the beginning of creation, she breaks down a book's original structure and function to reveal hidden layers of meaning within. Her creative process often begins with curiosity and a sense of wonder, sparked by the sensory experience of the book itself: its distinct smell, handwritten notes, or other traces of the life it once had.

Books that were once owned and cherished by someone carry a personal imprint, which, for the artist, becomes a compelling material beyond the book's physical form. Each work is meticulously crafted by hand using simple tools such as knives and scissors, through a repetitive process of cutting, tearing, and weaving. Through these actions, the artist creates a quiet but intricate dialogue between material and maker, and between artist and viewer, conveying new narratives and emotional resonance in every transformed book.

이탈리아 로마에 거주하며 작업하는 권죽희(*1981) 작가는 오래되고 버려진 책들을 섬세하고 다양한 형태의 종이 조각으로 변환시킨다. 작가는 책의 페이지를 자르고, 반죽하고, 찢고, 형태를 만드는 과정을 통해, 흘러내리는 '종이 폭포'부터 등지나 고치 같은 구상 조각, 그리고 추상적인 형상에 이르기까지 다양한 조각 작업을 완성한다. 그녀의 작품은 시적인 아름다움을 담은 창조물로, 무상함과 부재, 반복에 대한 명상적 탐구로 이어진다. 고서에 쓰인 활자들은 본연의 기능을 잃는 동시에 시간성을 부여받고, 새로운 의미를 얻게 된다. 권죽희 작가는 작품을 통해 모든 끝에는 또 다른 시작이 있음을 보여주며, 파괴와 소멸의 과정을 창조적 에너지로 전환시킨다.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Stella Sujin (*1983), living and working in Paris, challenges fixed ideas of femininity and their associated visual codes - such as flowers, vulvas, and crimson-lipped portraits - through her expressive watercolours. By confronting deeply ingrained visual conventions, she creates unsettling images that merge symbolism, surrealism, myth, and reality. Her works, at times elegant and at other times grotesque, invite viewers to question the assumptions that shape our perceptions.

프랑스 파리에서 거주하며 작업 활동을 이어가는 스텔라수진(*1983) 작가는 여성성에 대한 관념과 그것에 고정적으로 연관된 시각 언어인 꽃, 여성 성기, 진홍빛 입술의 초상을 통해 우리의 인식 속 고정관념에 질문을 던진다. 작가는 인식에 깊이 뿌리내린 전형적이고 공식적인 접근 방식에 맞서며, 수채화를 주요 매체로 사용한다. 감각적인 색채 팔레트와 불안감을 자아내는 이미지를 통해 상징과 초현실주의, 신화와 현실이 공존하는 장면들을 구축한다. 그녀의 작품은 때로는 미학적으로, 때로는 그로테스크하게 표현되며, 관람객들에게 고정된 관념을 다시 바라보게 하는 성찰의 문을 열어준다.







ABOUT THE ARTIST

Sejin Hong (*1992), based in Seoul, creates work grounded in her lived experience as a hearing-impaired artist. Able to perceive only sounds above 95 decibels, she transforms this sensory limitation into the basis for a new aesthetic language, where absence becomes its own form of sensory experience. Her paintings juxtapose pastel-toned geometry and symmetry with organic curves and translucent, veil-like surfaces, giving form to a deeply personal sensorial world.

서울에서 작업하는 홍세진(*1992) 작가의 작품은 제한된 청각 감각 속에서 살아가는 그녀의 삶에서 비롯된다. 작가는 일상적인 대화나 소리에는 접근할 수 없고, 오직 95데시벨 이상의 극단적인 굉음, 예를 들어 비행기 엔진 소리나 금속 충돌음 같은 소리만을 인지할 수 있다. 이러한 감각의 결핍과 단절은 단순히 소리를 시각화하는 데 그치지 않고, 새로운 감각의 가능성을 탐구하는 예술적 실천으로 확장된다.

작가는 회화와 설치를 통해 인간 감각의 비정형적 언어와 신체적 인지를 조형적으로 실험하며, 감각의 전환이 어떻게 또 다른 인식의 장을 열 수 있는지를 탐색한다. 파스텔 톤의 기하학적 구성, 완벽한 대칭과 유기적 곡선의 대비, 베일처럼 가려진 반투명한 표면은 모두 이러한 탐구의 시각적 결과물이다. 이처럼 감각 조건에 대한 사적인 체험에서 출발한 작업은 점차 사회적·기계적 현상으로까지 시선을 확장하며, 감각의 경계를 넘나드는 조형 언어를 통해 우리가 세계를 인식하고 구성하는 방식에 대한 새로운 질문을 던진다.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Sojeong Lee (*1993), living and working in Düsseldorf, translates her dreams and nightmares into rich symbolic imagery. Influenced by Freud's theories of the unconscious, she delicately captures emotional states such as loneliness and alienation in paint. Everyday objects like paper planes and raincoats take on new symbolic meaning, blending with figures that seem to drift between dream and reality, and imbuing her canvases with a unique emotional charge.


