## ABOUT THE ARTIST

Bertram Hasenauer, transitioning from sculptor to painter, charts a unique artistic path that plays with traditional approach to painting. Characterized by a distinctive muted palette and nuanced interplay of light and shadow, his oeuvre spans different genres of painting, delving into landscape and still-life painting whilst decidedly focusing on portraiture. Often commencing with photographs sourced from fashion magazines, Hasenauer undergoes a process of deconstruction and reconstruction, transforming them into collages that serve as prototypes for his compositions. The resulting portraits distill human existence into its essence, stripping off the veneer of consumerist excess. Whether depicting figures or interpreting still-life and landscapes, his reductionist approach delves into the core of human desire, urging viewers to grapple with the elusive.

조각으로 작업을 시작하여 회화 작가로 활동 중인 베르트람 하제나우어는 전통적인 접근 방법을 기반으로 회화에 대한 새로운 탐구를 제시한다. 특유의 부드러운 색감, 그리고 빛과 그림자의 미묘한 상호작용이 특징인 그의 작품은 초상화에 초점을 두지만 풍경화와 정물화와 같은 다양한 회화 장르를 함께 차용한다. 주로 패션 잡지에서 발견한 사진으로 시작하는 작업은 해체와 재구성의 과정을 통해 콜라주를 이미지를 만들고, 해당 이미지를 토대로 초상화를 그려내어 소비주의 문화의 허영과 허풍이 배제된 인간의 근본을 형상화한다. 이러한 환원주의적 접근법은 초상화뿐만 아니라 작가의 정물화 및 풍경화 작품에서도 확인할 수 있다. 하제나우어의 작업은 존재성의 핵심에 파고들며, 결코 가질 수 없는 무언가를 갈망하는 인간의 열망에 대한 고찰을 보여준다.

## ABOUT THE ARTIST

Bertram Hasenauer (b. 1970 in Saalfelden, Austria) received BFA in The Academy of Fine Arts, Vienna and MFA in fine arts at the Central Saint Martins College, London. He has had a number of major solo shows including 'Bertram Hasenauer' (Memmingen Kunsthalle, Germany, 2023); 'Eight Minutes' (Kristen Hjellegjerde Gallery, London, 2023); 'The Pines Were Trapped For Resin' (2016) and 'September' (2014) (Mario Mauroner Contemporary Art, Salzburg); 'Súlur' (Museum der Moderne Salzburg Repertinum, 2010); and 'Tomorrow will be different' (Strabag Kunstforum, Austria, 2007). His recent group exhibitions include 'HUMAN' (CHOI&CHOI Gallery, Seoul, 2023) and 'New Black Romanticism' (Künstlerhaus Bethanien, Stadtgalerie Kiel, et al. (travelling), 2017-2018) among others.

Hasenauer was awarded a recognition prize of ART AWARD from Strabag in 2006 and was the recipient of the Georg Eisler award for painting in 2008. His works can be found in The Bunker (Collection of Beth Rudin Dewoody, Florida, USA); LACMA (LA, USA); Berlinische Galerie (Berlin, Germany); Österreichische Galerie Belvedere (Vienna, Austria); Museum der Moderne (Salzburg, Austria); Universalmuseum Joanneum (Graz, Austria); The City of Vienna (Vienna, Austria) among other museum and institutional collections, and other private collections worldwide. Hasenauer lives and works in Berlin.

베르트람 하제나우어(1970년 오스트리아 출생)는 비엔나 미술 아카데미에서 1997년에 졸업 후 런던 센트럴 세인트 마틴 대학교에서 석사학위를 수료하였다. 작가는 지난 20여년 동안 'Bertram Hasenauer' (메밍겐 쿤스트할레 미술관, 독일, 2023) 'Eight Minutes' (크리스틴 엘레야데 갤러리, 런던, 2023), 'The Pines Were Trapped For Resin' (마리오 모러너 갤러리, 잘츠부르크, 2016)과 'September' (마리오 모러너 갤러리, 잘츠부르크, 2014), 'Súlur' (잘츠부르크 현대미술관, 오스트리아, 2010), 'Tomorrow will be different' (스트라바그 쿤스트 포럼, 오스트리아, 2007) 등 포함한 다수의 개인전을 선보였으며, 근 몇년간 'HUMAN' (초이앤초이 갤러리, 서울, 2023), 'New Black Romanticism' (유럽 미술관 순회전, 2017 - 2018) 등의 단체전에 참여한 바 있다.

하제나우어의 작품은 베스 루딘 드우드 벙커 컬렉션 (미국, 플로리다 주), LACMA 미술관 (미국, 로스앤젤레스), 베를린 시립 미술관 (독일, 베를린), 벨베데르 궁전 미술관 (오스트리아, 빈), 잘츠부르크 현대미술관 (오스트리아, 잘츠부르크), 요아네움 박물관 (오스트리아, 그라츠), 빈 시립 컬렉션 (오스트리아, 빈) 등 전 세계의 다양한 미술관 및 기관 컬렉션에 소장되어 있다. 작가는 현재 독일 베를린에서 거주하며 활동 중이다.
