## ABOUT THE ARTIST

The worn out industrial-era buildings depicted in Jung's works ultimately reflect the country's attitude of neglect and denial toward its own tumultuous past. He urges us to remember the lives that once dwelled behind the concrete walls - lives that endured and persevered.

The crux of his work is the representation of the "odor of life" permeated in the surface. To the artist, the act of painting is a means to recall forgotten memories - a means to reanimate things that are lost in the past. Therefore, the process of recreation is not merely a practice of imitation for the artist. Through his work, Jung traces and collects the marks of modern times.
